Thank you for your interest in becoming a member of the St. Andrew's Society of Washington, D.C.

Society By-laws stipulate that "The members of the Saint Andrew's Society of Washington, D.C. shall be males of the age of 18 or over, who may be active, life, or honorary members. Active and life membership shall be limited to men who were born in Scotland or who are lineally descended from one or more natives of Scotland."

Membership in the Society is a long-term commitment, neither quickly acquired nor lightly relinquished. The application process requires a demonstration of a Scottish ancestor. The gentlemen of the Society cherish our common bond of Scottish ancestry and we expect you to respect that indelible connection among us.

The Society is more than just a heritage organization. The National Capital Area was founded and shaped by Scots and the gentlemen of the Society are a part of that rich heritage. We reinforce that legacy through the Society's charitable efforts, cultural activities, traditions, and fellowship. You will be expected to share in those efforts, whether by volunteering your time, donating your funds and services, or simply continuing to pay your dues.

For consideration of Membership, please provide the following:

- 1. *Application for Membership: Personal Information and Sponsorship*. Before applying, you are encouraged to attend Society events and meet current members who may be willing to sponsor you. Please contact us and we will assist you.
- 2. *Application for Membership: Scottish Lineage:* Please provide accurate lineage that indicates that you were either born in Scotland or that you are a direct descendent from an ancestor born in Scotland. This will be carefully reviewed by the Membership Committee, which will assist you in correcting any inaccuracies. If you are having difficulty tracing your ancestry, please join the Society's Genealogy Group which will guide you through the process.
- 3. *Cover letter:* Please include a one-page letter that explains your desire in becoming a member of the Society, indicates your specific interests in Scottish culture, includes your membership in other organizations, provides a brief summary of your career, and any other information that you believe will be useful in our assessment. You should also emphasize, as well, what you foresee giving to and receiving from the Society in terms of involvement, time, and interest.
- 4. *Check to Cover Application Fee*: Please make your check in the amount of \$150 (\$100 for membership and \$50 for application), made payable to the St. Andrew's Society of Washington, D.C. If your application is accepted, this will cover the cost of your first year of membership. If your application is not accepted, your funds will be returned.

Please DO NOT give your application package to any Member of the Society, even your Sponsor(s). Please mail all four (4) items named above to Membership Chairman at the address below. The Society must receive your check before the application may be considered.

Your application package will be circulated among the Governance Group and your name will be posted to the full Membership for comments. If after 30 days no Member raises an objection, the Board of Managers will consider your application and vote for approval or rejection. The Board meets once a month, except for a hiatus during the summer months. You will be notified of your status by the Membership Chairmen. If your application is approved, you will be formally invested at the next Membership Meeting Dinner.
